

## Environmental Policy

The company will:

This will include working to reduce to the lowest practical minimum the level of pollution caused by reducing energy consumption and harmful emissions from the operations, and including vehicles, buildings, storage, equipment and waste.
- Inform and improve awareness amongst everyone working for or on behalf of the company organisation, including contractors, subcontractors, temporary staff and remote workers.
- Work with suppliers to minimise the impact of their operations through a partnership approach with the purchasing policy and to develop where practical new products and services which seek to achieve greater sustainability.
- Work with customers to provide training in environmental awareness and best practice in the use and safe disposal of products.
- Provide a waste management service to customers that will ensure the safe collection and disposal of hazardous chemical waste.
